

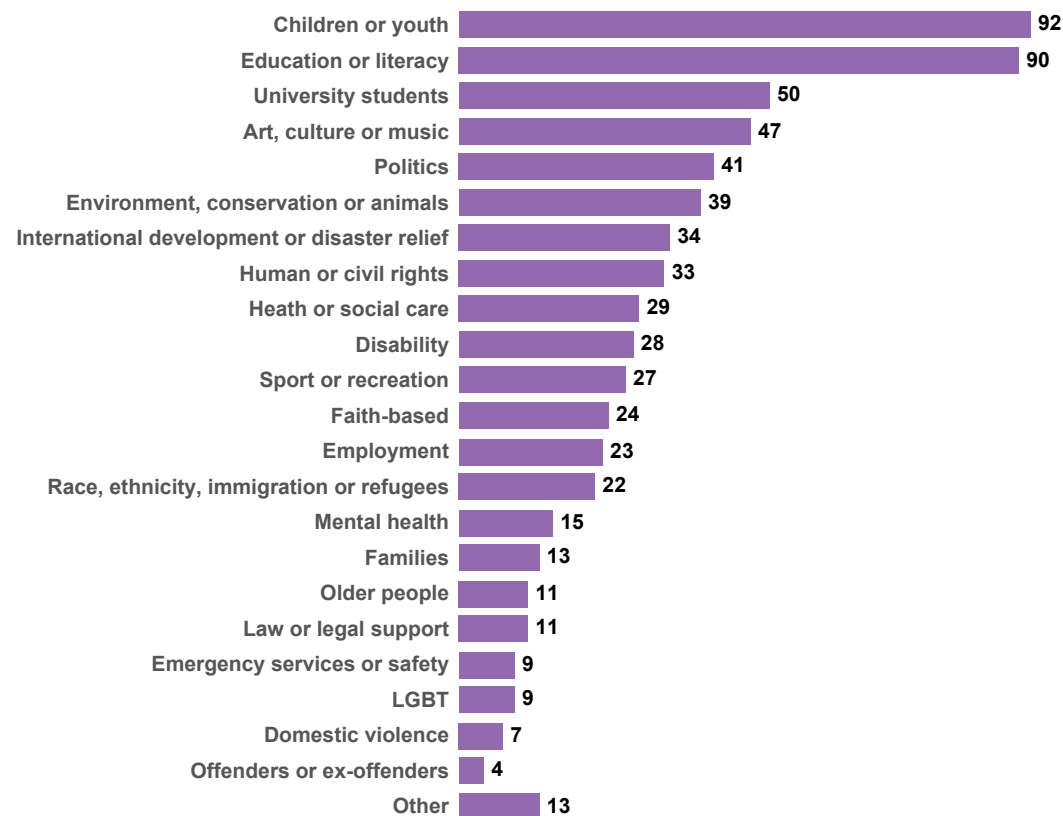
Volunteering research 2015

Volunteer Centre

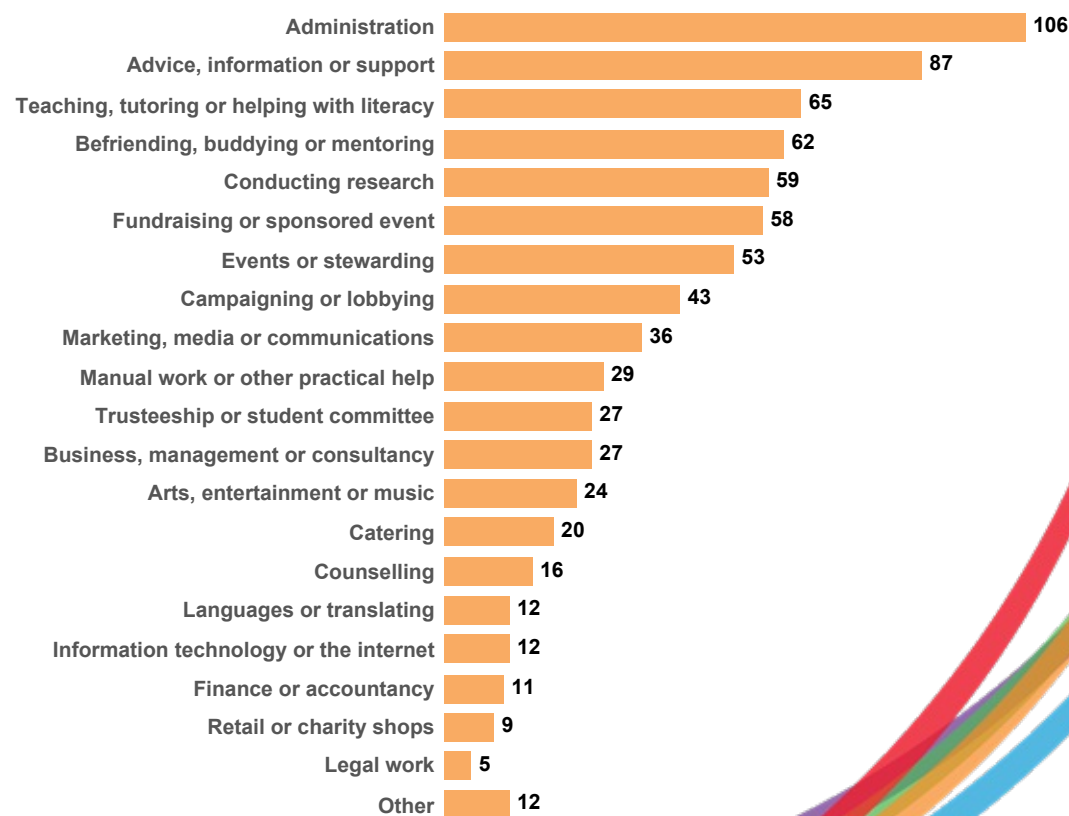
The survey was sent to current students and alumni during January 2015, **537** responses were received.

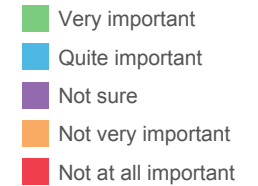
Which of the following best describes the organisation(s) that you have worked with?



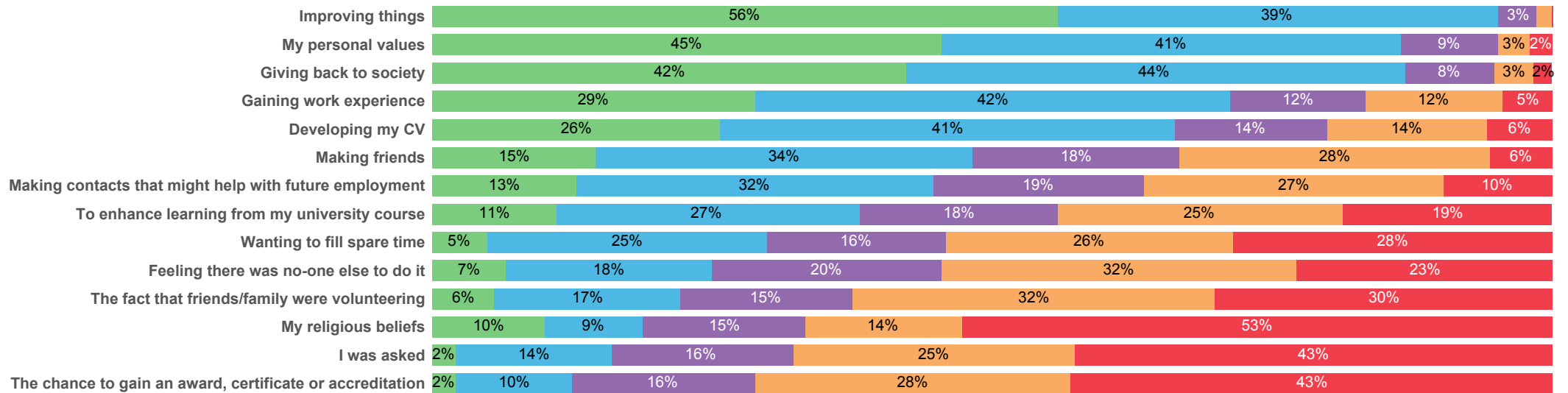
Which of these best describes the work you carried out?



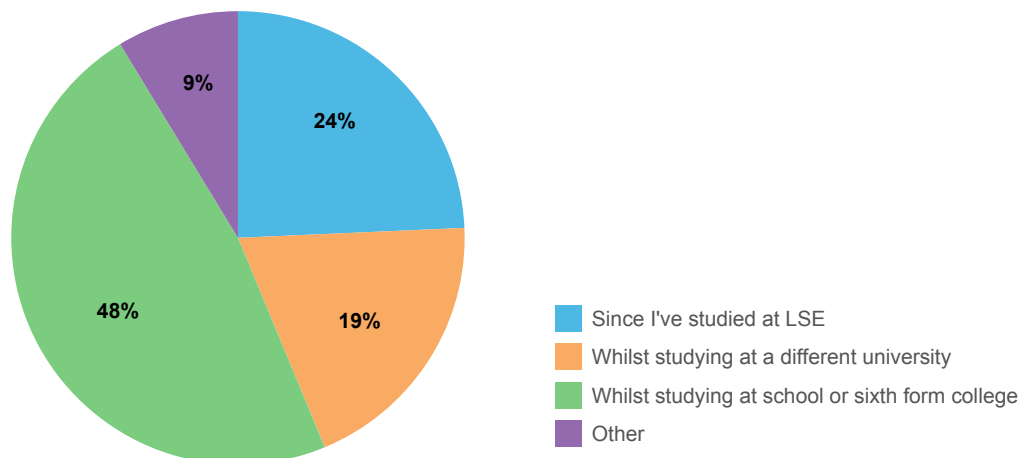

Can you indicate which of the following were important to you as reasons for starting volunteering?



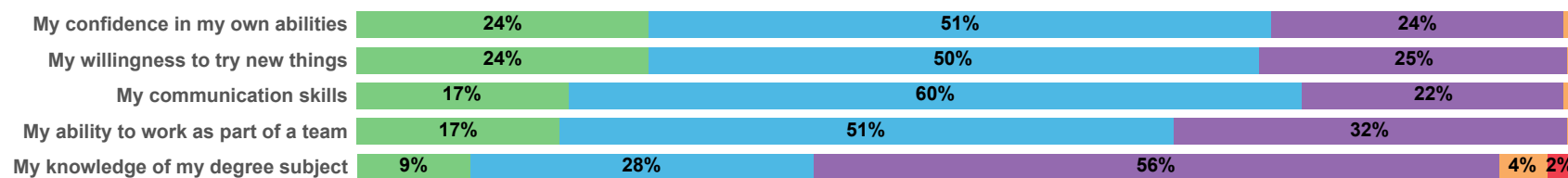
When did you first get involved with volunteering?



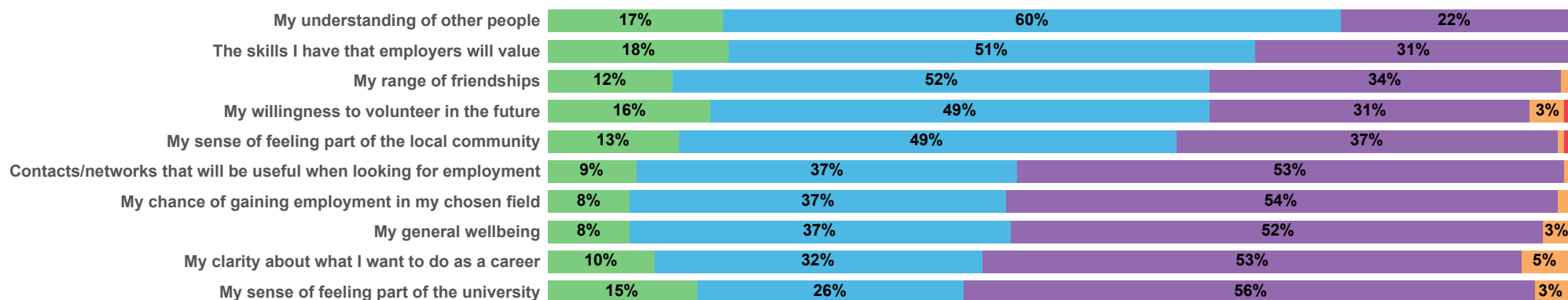

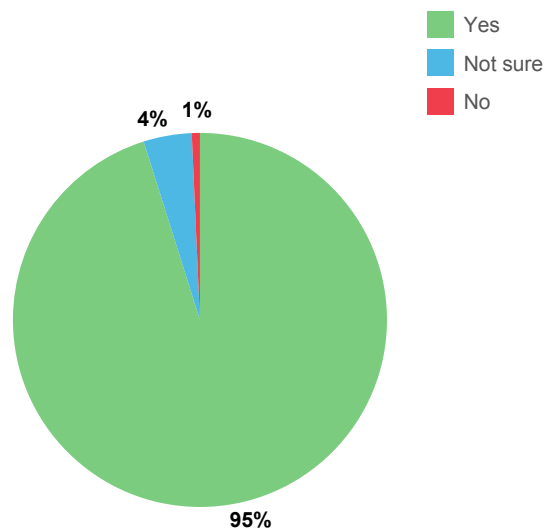
When do you volunteer?

56% of students volunteer all year round

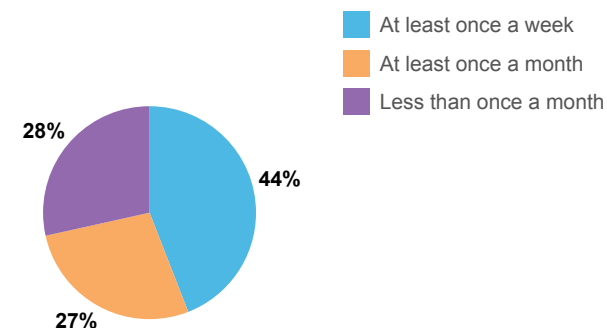
15% only volunteer outside of term time

30% of students volunteer only during term time

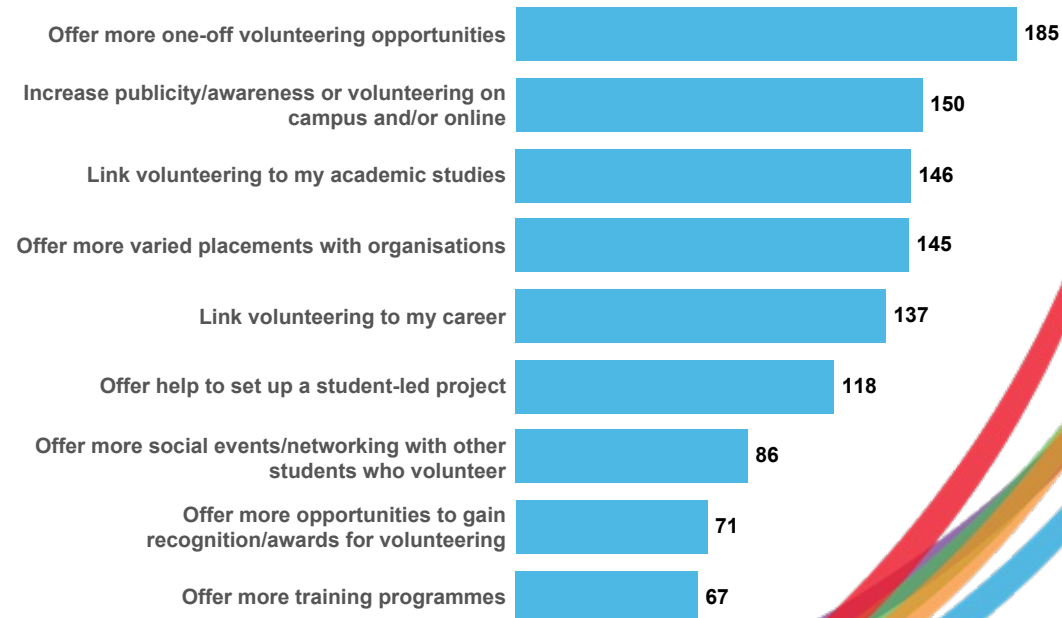
Would you recommend volunteering to your friends?



How often do you volunteer?



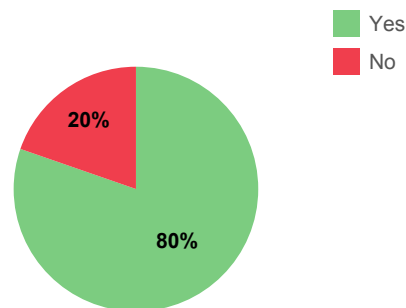
What could the LSE do to encourage you to volunteer more in the future?



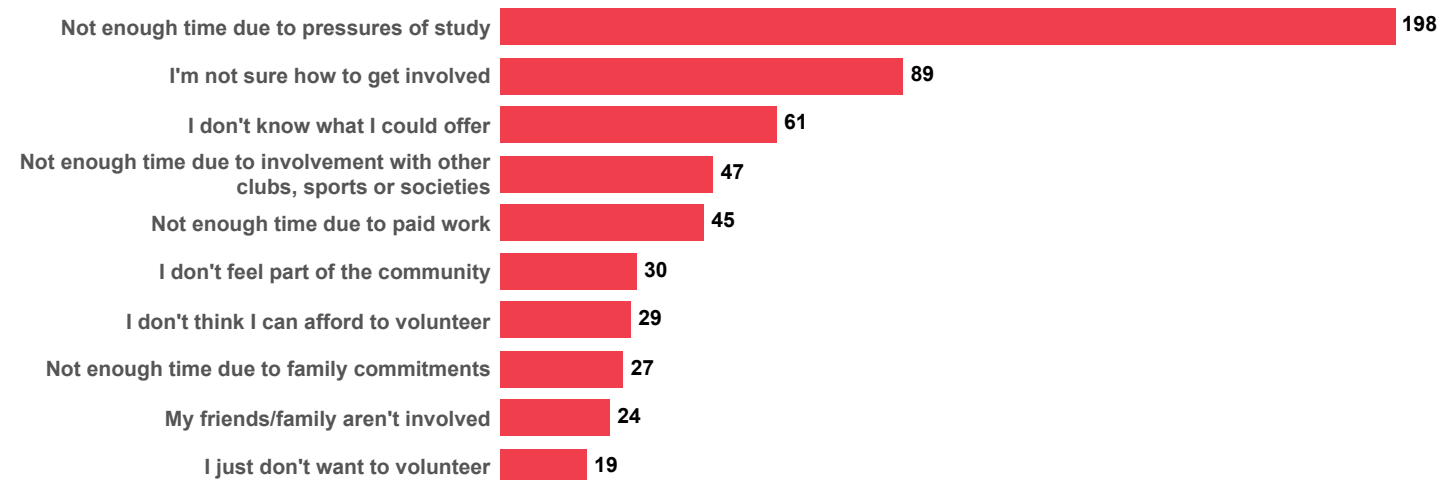

The respondents who said they had not volunteered since joining LSE were asked a separate set of questions. The responses are outlined below.

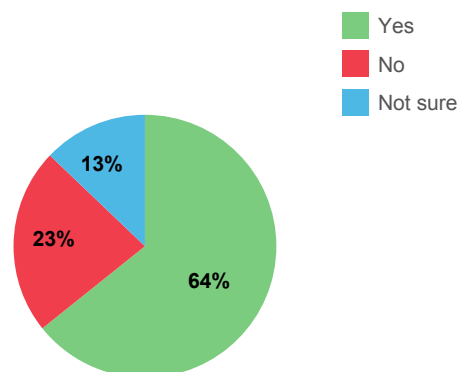
Did you volunteer before you came to LSE?
